ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must have a valid NEET scorecard and meet the qualifying criteria.
- Age: Must be 17 years or older as of December 31, 2026.
- Academics: Completion of 10+2 education with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology as main subjects.
- Minimum marks: Specific percentage requirements in 10+2 may apply; check the university website.
- Passport: A valid passport is required for international travel and visa processing.
- Visa: Must obtain a student visa to study MBBS in Russia.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: June.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the Altai State Medical University eligibility criteria, as failure to do so will result in disqualification.
2. Step 2: Qualify for the NEET exam and obtain a valid NEET scorecard, which is a mandatory requirement for Indian students.

3. Step 3: Visit the university's official website to access and fill out the online application form with accurate details.
4. Step 4: Complete the application form with all the required information as per your official documents.
5. Step 5: Submit all necessary documents, including your NEET scorecard and original passport, as part of the application.
6. Step 6: Pay the registration fee as per the instructions provided on the university website.
