ELIGIBILITY

- **NEET score:** Must qualify in NEET-UG with a valid score for the 2026 academic year.
- **Age:** Applicant must be 17 years or older as of December 31, 2026.
- **Academics:** Completion of 10+2 or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology as core subjects.

- Minimum marks: A minimum aggregate of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in 10+2.
- English proficiency: Good understanding and fluency in English are generally required.
- Nationality: Must be an Indian citizen or hold valid Indian residency status.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: NEET Qualification: Ensure you qualify for the NEET-UG exam, as it is mandatory for MBBS admission in Armenia for Indian students.
2. Step 2: Application Submission: Apply to Apolia Medical Institute with all required documents, including academic transcripts and NEET score card.
3. Step 3: Eligibility Check: The university will verify your documents and NEET score to confirm your eligibility for the MBBS program.
4. Step 4: Offer Letter: If eligible, you will receive an offer letter from the university outlining the terms and conditions of admission.
5. Step 5: Tuition Fee Payment: Pay the initial tuition fee as specified in the offer letter to secure your seat at the university.
6. Step 6: Visa Application: Begin the visa application process at the Armenian embassy or consulate in India.
