ELIGIBILITY

- **NEET score:** Qualification in NEET is mandatory for Indian students.
- **Age:** Must be 17 years or older by December 31, 2026.
- **Education:** Completion of 10+2 or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.

- **Minimum Marks:** As per NMC guidelines, specific minimum marks in 10+2 are required.
- **Entrance Exams:** May require entrance exams like ACET (Ateneo) or DLSUAT.
- **Passport:** A valid passport is required for international students.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. **Step 1: Choose a Program:** Select the Doctor of Medicine (MD/MBBS) program at Ateneo de Iloilo, aligning with your medical career aspirations.
2. **Step 2: Verify Eligibility:** Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including NEET qualification for Indian students planning to practice in India.
3. **Step 3: Obtain Application Form:** Get the application form from the Ateneo de Iloilo official website or the admissions office.
4. **Step 4: Prepare Documents:** Gather necessary documents, including academic transcripts authenticated by the Philippine Embassy if from a foreign...
5. **Step 5: NEET Scorecard:** Keep your NEET scorecard ready, as it is a mandatory document for Indian students.
6. **Step 6: Recommendation Form:** For Grade 4 to Grade 11 applicants, a recommendation form must be completed by the applicant's teacher or advisor.
