History and Establishment Batumi Shota Rustaveli State University (BSU) was established in 1923 in the coastal city of Batumi, the capital of Georgia's Adjara region. Named after the known Georgian poet Shota Rustaveli, the institution began its preparatory courses in 1935 under the leadership of its first director, Khusein Nakaidze. Over the past century, the university has evolved from a regional educational center into a multifunctional medical school with over 6,000 students enrolled across Bachelor, Master, and Doctoral programs. ELIGIBILITY

- **NEET Qualification:** Must qualify for the NEET exam in 2026 as per NMC guidelines.
- **Age Requirement:** Applicant must be at least 17 years old by December 31st of the admission year.
- **Academic Qualification:** 12th standard (or equivalent) with a minimum of 50% marks.
- **Core Subjects:** Mandatory subjects in 12th standard include Biology, Physics, and Chemistry.
- **Minimum Marks in PCB:** Achieve a combined score of at least 60% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- **Language Proficiency:** University may conduct a language assessment if no certificate is available.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including being at least 17 years old by the end of 2026.
2. Step 2: Achieve a minimum of 50% marks in your higher secondary (12th standard) examination with Biology, Physics, and Chemistry as main subjects.
3. Step 3: Qualify for the National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET) exam, which is compulsory for Indian students seeking MBBS admission.
4. Step 4: General category candidates require 50% scores in NEET, while SC/ST/OBC candidates need 45% scores to be eligible.
5. Step 5: Prepare the necessary documents, including a passport with at least 18 months validity and your birth certificate.
6. Step 6: Obtain your official higher secondary school certificate (12th standard mark sheet) and other academic transcripts.
