- Mandatory Subjects: Physics, Chemistry, and Biology must be included in secondary education.
- Language Proficiency: Proficiency in English is generally required as the MBBS program is taught in English.
- NMC Approval: The university must be approved by the National Medical Commission (NMC) of India.

1. Step 1: Academic Qualification: Ensure completion of secondary education (or equivalent) from a recognized board with Physics, Chemistry, and...
2. Step 2: NEET Qualification: Qualify for the NEET (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test) as it is a prerequisite for Indian students seeking MBBS...
3. Step 3: Application Submission: Obtain and complete the application form from Beni-Suef University Faculty of Medicine, either online or through...
4. Step 4: Document Verification: Submit all required documents, including academic transcripts, NEET score card, passport copy, and other relevant...
5. Step 5: Eligibility Check: The university will assess your eligibility based on academic qualifications and NEET score as per NMC guidelines.
6. Step 6: Offer Letter: If eligible, receive an offer letter from Beni-Suef University Faculty of Medicine confirming your provisional admission.
