- Minimum marks: Specific percentage in PCB may be required.
- Nationality: Indian national or eligible as per prevailing regulations.

2. Step 2: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including qualification proofs and required test scores like IELTS for international students.
3. Step 3: Submit all necessary documents as per the guidelines provided by the university's admission department for the MBBS program.
4. Step 4: Pay the application fee as specified by BPKIHS. Check the official website for the current fee structure and payment methods.
5. Step 5: Await communication from BPKIHS regarding the status of your application and any further instructions.
6. Step 6: If shortlisted, prepare for any entrance exams or interviews that BPKIHS may conduct as part of the selection process.
