- **English Proficiency:** Basic English proficiency is required as the medium of instruction is English.
- **Nationality:** Open to Indian and other international students.
- **Application Form:** Complete the application form with accurate details.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Fill out the application form for Bukhara State Medical Institute with all required details.

3. Step 3: Pay the enrollment expenses to Bukhara State Medical Institute as specified in the offer letter.
4. Step 4: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including NEET qualification for Indian students, to study MBBS at Bukhara State Medical Institute.
5. Step 5: Provide all necessary documents, including academic transcripts, NEET scores, and identification proof.
6. Step 6: International students may need to provide English proficiency test scores, depending on program requirements.
