ELIGIBILITY

- NEET Qualification: Mandatory for Indian students as per NMC guidelines.
- Age: Must be 17 years or older before December 31, 2026.
- Academic Qualification: Passed higher secondary (12th grade) with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- Minimum Marks: Aggregate of 50% or more in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in 12th grade.
- English Proficiency: A B2 level of English proficiency is generally required.
- Application Period: Applications typically accepted from April to May for the 2026 intake.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the NEET criteria, as qualification is mandatory for Indian students seeking MBBS admission at Carol Davila University.
2. Step 2: Verify you have passed the higher secondary examination with Science subjects (Physics, Chemistry, and Biology).
3. Step 3: Confirm you have an aggregate of 50% or more in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in your 12th standard results.
4. Step 4: Ensure you are at least 17 years old to be eligible for medical education at this university.
5. Step 5: Prepare your application between April and May 2026, the typical application period for Carol Davila University.
6. Step 6: Gather all required documents, including academic transcripts, NEET score card, and proof of English proficiency (B2 level).
