ELIGIBILITY

- **NEET Qualification:** Must qualify for the NEET exam in 2024, 2025, or 2026.
- **12th Standard:** Completion of 10+2 or equivalent (HSC) from a recognized board (CBSE, ICSE, State Boards).
- **Minimum Marks:** General category students need 50% marks (PCB) in 12th/Inter/Equivalent.
- **Reserved Category:** Reserved category students require 40% marks in 12th/Inter/Equivalent.
- **Age Requirement:** Applicant must be 17+ years as of December 31, 2026.
- **Qualifying Subjects:** Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB) must be included in 12th standard.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Submit scans of your 12th grade mark sheets, passport, and NEET qualification (2026/2025/2024) to the university online or at an office.
2. Step 2: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria: 50% marks in PCB for general category or 40% for reserved categories in 12th/Inter/Equivalent.
3. Step 3: Confirm you have qualified for the NEET exam in 2026, 2025, or 2024 as per NMC guidelines for studying MBBS abroad.
4. Step 4: Complete your 10+2 (HSC) or equivalent from a recognized board like CBSE, ICSE, or State Boards to meet basic academic requirements.
5. Step 5: Apply online through the Central Asian International Medical University website or visit an authorized admission office.
6. Step 6: Prepare required documents, including academic transcripts, passport copy, NEET score card, and other documents as specified by the...
