ELIGIBILITY

- NEET Requirement: Must have appeared for the NEET exam.
- NEET Score: Secure qualifying marks in NEET (60% suggested).
- Subjects: Physics, Chemistry, and Biology are prerequisite subjects.
- Age: Minimum age requirements not specified in provided data.
- Academic Qualification: Equivalent to SSC and HSC qualifications.
- Minimum Marks: Similar results as specified by the Bangladesh government.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Appear for the NEET exam. This is a mandatory first step for Indian students seeking MBBS admission in Bangladesh.
2. Step 2: Secure a minimum of 60% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in the NEET exam to meet the basic eligibility criteria.
3. Step 3: Ensure you have studied Biology, Physics, and Chemistry in your higher secondary education, as these subjects are a prerequisite.
4. Step 4: Download the MBBS admission form from the Bangladesh Foreign Ministry website, if you meet the initial eligibility requirements.
5. Step 5: Fill out the downloaded admission form with your medical college choices, ensuring all details are accurate and complete.
6. Step 6: Submit the filled application form along with all required documents before the deadline, as specified by the college for the 2026-2027...
