ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Qualified in NEET, mandatory for Indian students.
- Age: Minimum 17 years old at the time of admission.
- Academics: Completed SSC (Class 10) & HSC (Class 12) or equivalent.
- GPA: Minimum GPA of 9.00 (combined SSC & HSC scores).
- Direct Admission: NEET-qualified Indian students get priority.
- Application: Submit application with passport, transcripts, NEET scorecard.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: October.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including completion of SSC (Class 10) and HSC (Class 12) or equivalent.
2. Step 2: As an Indian student, confirm you are NEET-qualified. NEET-qualified students are given priority for direct admission at CBMCB.
3. Step 3: Obtain the application form from the Community Based Medical College Bangladesh (CBMCB) official website or admission office.
4. Step 4: Fill out the application form accurately with all required details, ensuring no fields are left blank.
5. Step 5: Gather all necessary documents, including your passport, academic transcripts, and NEET scorecard (if applicable).
6. Step 6: Submit your completed application form along with the required documents to the college.
