HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including being at least 17 years old by December 31, 2026, and having 50% marks in Physics,...
2. Step 2: Obtain the application form from Emilio Aguinaldo College (EAC) either online or directly from the admissions office.
3. Step 3: Submit the completed application form along with required documents such as your 10th and 12th mark sheets, NEET scorecard, and passport copy.
4. Step 4: Provide a qualifying English proficiency test certificate, administered by Aguinaldo International Language Institute, if required.
5. Step 5: Await the admission/offer letter from Emilio Aguinaldo College after the review of your application.
6. Step 6: Once you receive the admission letter, apply for the Philippines 9F Student Visa at the Philippines embassy or consulate in India.
