- **NEET Qualification:** Mandatory NEET qualification as per NMC guidelines.

- Academic Qualification: Pass SSC or equivalent exam.
- HSC Requirement: Pass HSC or equivalent with a total GPA of 9.
- Biology GPA: Minimum GPA of 3.5 in Biology at HSC level.
- Class 10 & 12 Timing: Class 10 passed no earlier than 2022.
- Class 12 Timing: Class 12 passed in 2024 or 2025.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including passing the SSC or equivalent exam and HSC with required GPA scores, especially in...
2. Step 2: Qualify for the NEET exam, as it is mandatory for Indian students seeking MBBS admission abroad, according to the National Medical...
3. Step 3: Be aware that the NEET result remains valid for three years from the date of declaration, so plan your application accordingly for the 2026...
4. Step 4: All foreign applications must be submitted through the official DGME online portal: foreignstudents.dgme.gov.bd. No direct admissions are...
5. Step 5: Note that applications for non-government medical colleges opened on 11 November 2025 and will close on 15 January 2026.
6. Step 6: Ensure you passed Class 10 no earlier than 2022 and Class 12 in either 2024 or 2025, with the Class 12 examination completed within three...
