ELIGIBILITY

- NEET Qualification: Required for Indian students seeking MBBS admission.
- Age Requirement: Applicants must be 17+ years as of December 31, 2026.
- Academic Qualification: Completion of 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and English.
- Minimum PCB Score: Students must have at least 80% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- HSK-4 Proficiency: Required before receiving the MBBS degree from Jiangsu University.
- IELTS/Other Exams: International students may need to submit valid scores.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Check eligibility criteria, including NEET UG qualification, and ensure you meet the academic requirements of 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry,...
2. Step 2: Prepare required documents such as academic transcripts, passport copy, NEET scorecard, and other documents as specified by Jiangsu...
3. Step 3: Apply online through the Jiangsu University website or authorized representatives, ensuring all information is accurate and complete.
4. Step 4: Submit your application before the deadline, which is typically around June 15th each year, but no later than June 30th for consideration.
5. Step 5: Await the pre-admission letter, which usually takes 7-10 days after a successful application.
6. Step 6: Pay the tuition fee to Jiangsu University's bank account after receiving the pre-admission letter.
