## ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify NEET in 2024, 2025, or 2026.
- Academics: 50% marks in 12th (PCB) for general category.
- Reserved Category: 40% marks in 12th (PCB) if applicable.

- Age: Minimum 17 years old as of December 31, 2026.
- Qualifying Exam: 12th/Inter/Equivalent examination pass.
- Passport: Valid passport is required for application.

## HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Submit scans of your 12th standard mark sheet, passport, and NEET qualification (2024, 2025, or 2026) to the university.
2. Step 2: Ensure you have secured at least 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in your 12th standard if you belong to the general category.
3. Step 3: Reserved category students (SC/ST/OBC) need to have a minimum of 40% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in their 12th standard.
4. Step 4: Verify that you have qualified for the NEET exam in 2024, 2025, or 2026 as per NMC guidelines.
5. Step 5: Apply for MBBS admission at Kyrgyz State Medical Academy online or visit their office with a prior appointment.
6. Step 6: Ensure you apply for MBBS in Kyrgyzstan at least 2 to 3 months before the admission deadline.
