Historical Foundation and Institutional Legacy Lanzhou University traces its origins to 1909, when it was established as the Gansu Law and Politics School, marking the beginning of modern higher education in Gansu Province and serving as a forerunner of academic progress in northwest China. The institution underwent several transformations, becoming the Sun Yat-sen University of Lanzhou in 1928 and the National Lanzhou University in 1945, before adopting its current name after 1949. The medical faculty has equally deep roots, with the Lanzhou Medical College and its affiliated hospital founded in 1932. In 2004, the Lanzhou Medical College was officially incorporated into Lanzhou University, creating the current School of Medicine that benefits...

- **NEET score:** Qualifying score as per NMC guidelines is required.
- **Age:** Minimum 17 years of age by December 31, 2026.
- **Academics:** Completion of 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.

- English Proficiency: MBBS program is taught in English.
- NMC Recognition: University is recognized by the National Medical Commission (NMC).
- WHO Recognition: University is listed in the World Directory of Medical Schools (WDOMS).

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including NEET qualification, as required for Indian students seeking MBBS admission abroad.
2. Step 2: Apply online through the university's official portal or authorized representatives for the 2026–2027 academic year.
3. Step 3: Submit all required documents, including academic transcripts, NEET score card, passport copy, and other relevant certificates.
4. Step 4: Pay the application fee, which may range from RMB 400 to RMB 1000 (approximately INR 4,600 to INR 11,500), depending on the university.
5. Step 5: Await the university's review of your application and verification of your documents.
6. Step 6: If shortlisted, you may be required to attend an interview, either online or in person.

- Birth certificate (English)
- Medical fitness & HIV test report
- Passport-size photographs (white background)
- 6-month bank statement of parent/guardian
- No-Objection Certificate
