Historical Foundation and Institutional Legacy Danylo Halytsky Lviv National Medical University is one of the oldest medical institutions in Ukraine, tracing its origins to November 16, 1784, when the Medical Faculty of Lviv University first opened under the privilege of Austrian Emperor Josef II. The university derives its name from King Daniel of Galicia (Danylo Halytsky), the historical founder of Lviv in 1256 AD. In 2009, the institution celebrated its 225th anniversary, marking over two centuries of continuous medical education. Formerly known as Lviv State Medical Institute, the university received its state title in 1996, solidifying its position as a premier national medical university. ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify NEET with minimum required percentile.
- Age: Must be 17 years or older by December 31, 2026.
- Academics: 50% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in 10+2 (General category).
- Academics: 40% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in 10+2 (Reserved category).
- Mandatory Subjects: Higher secondary education (10+2) with Physics, Chemistry, Biology.
- English Proficiency: Good command of the English language is required.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including being 17 years old by the admission year 2026 and having passed 10+2 with Physics,...
2. Step 2: Achieve a minimum of 50% marks in PCB in your 10+2 exams if you belong to the general category (40% for reserved categories).
3. Step 3: Qualify for the NEET exam. A valid NEET scorecard is a mandatory requirement for Indian students seeking MBBS admission.
4. Step 4: Fill out the Lviv National Medical University application form, available online, ensuring all information provided is accurate.
5. Step 5: Submit all required scanned documents to the university for initial assessment. The admissions office email is dep foreign...
6. Step 6: Await the invitation letter from the university, which is typically issued within 2 weeks of application submission.
