- NEET score: Must qualify for NEET as per NMC guidelines for 2026.
- Age: Minimum 17 years old as of December 31, 2026.
- Academics: Completion of 10+2 or equivalent with required subjects.
- Subjects: Physics, Chemistry, and Biology as core subjects in 10+2.
- Documents: Notarized copies of required documents must be submitted.
- Application: Apply online and submit required documents on the website.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: July.

1. Step 1: Check your eligibility for the MBBS program at Lyceum Northwestern University, ensuring you meet the necessary academic qualifications.
2. Step 2: Prepare notarized copies of all required documents as specified by the university for international students.
3. Step 3: Visit the Lyceum Northwestern University website and apply online for the MBBS program.
4. Step 4: Submit the scanned copies of all required documents through the online application portal.
5. Step 5: Pay the non-refundable application fee of 1000 pesos (approximately INR 1,400) at the Cashier's Office.
6. Step 6: Await the issuance of the admission letter from Lyceum Northwestern University upon successful review of your application.
