ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify NEET with a minimum score as per NMC guidelines.
- Age: Minimum 17 years old as of December 31, 2026.
- Academics: Completion of 10+2 or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- Subjects: Minimum marks in PCB and English as per university requirements.
- NMAT: Some universities require the National Medical Admission Test (NMAT) for admission.
- Medical Certificate: Submission of a medical fitness certificate.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the age criteria: be at least 17 years old and not older than 25 by 2026.
2. Step 2: Qualify for NEET. Passing the NEET exam is mandatory for Indian students seeking MBBS admission in the Philippines.
3. Step 3: Prepare required documents, including academic transcripts, NEET score card, and proof of age.
4. Step 4: Obtain and submit official NMAT scores to your selected Philippines university. NMAT is often required for admission.
5. Step 5: Apply to NMC-approved medical colleges in the Philippines offering the Doctor of Medicine (MD) program.
6. Step 6: Check the university's specific admission criteria, as some may have minimum passing marks in NMAT.
