- NEET score: Must qualify in the NEET exam for Indian students.
- Age: 17+ years as of December 31, 2026 (expected).
- Minimum Marks: 75% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB) in Class XII.
- Academic Qualification: High school diploma or equivalent is required.
- Entrance Exams: Passing entrance exams may be required.
- Application Deadline: Apply before June 2025 for the 2025–2026 session.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including a minimum of 75% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in Class XII.
2. Step 2: Qualify for the NEET exam, as it is mandatory for Indian students seeking MBBS admission abroad.
3. Step 3: Gather all required documents, including academic transcripts, NEET score card, and passport-sized photographs.
4. Step 4: Apply online through the university's official website or designated admission portals before the June 2025 deadline for the 2025–2026...
5. Step 5: Pay the application fee as specified by Mansoura University; details can be found on their website.
6. Step 6: Await the university's review of your application, which may include verification of documents and NEET scores.
