ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify in the NEET-UG exam conducted by the NTA.
- Age: Must have completed 17 years as of December 31, 2026.
- Academic Qualification: 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology with a minimum percentage.

- Nationality: Indian national or eligible NRI/OCI candidate.
- Qualifying Exam: Must pass the entrance exam for admission upon arrival at the university.
- Female Candidates Only: This medical college is exclusively for female students.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the age criteria; you must be 17 years old by December 31st of the admission year (2026).
2. Step 2: Qualify for the NEET-UG examination conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) as it is a mandatory requirement for MBBS admission in...
3. Step 3: Check the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) website for updates on MBBS online counseling schedules and procedures.
4. Step 4: Be aware that admission to government medical colleges is highly competitive, while private medical colleges generally have higher fees.
5. Step 5: Prepare all necessary documents, including NEET result/admit card and ID proof (Aadhar, PAN, Driving License, or Passport).
6. Step 6: Apply to Symbiosis Medical College for Women (SMCW) following the guidelines available on their official website.
