ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Qualification in NEET is mandatory for Indian students.
- Age: Minimum 17 years of age as of December 31, 2026.
- 10+2: Minimum 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (40% for SC/ST).
- PCB Subjects: Physics, Chemistry, and Biology must be included in 10+2.
- NMAT Exam: You have to apply online with the NMAT Score.
- School Certificate: A School Transfer Certificate is required.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including a minimum of 50% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in your 12th standard and NEET...
2. Step 2: Obtain your NEET scorecard, as it is a mandatory document for admission to medical colleges in the Philippines.
3. Step 3: Prepare necessary documents such as your school transfer certificate and a medical check-up certificate.
4. Step 4: Apply online to the chosen medical university, such as UV Gullas College of Medicine or AMA School of Medicine.
5. Step 5: Submit your NMAT (National Medical Admission Test) score along with your application.
6. Step 6: Await the university's review of your application form and the issuance of an acceptance letter.
