ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Qualifying score as per NMC guidelines for the year 2026 is required.
- Age: Minimum 17 years as of December 31, 2026, is generally required.
- Academics: High school scores in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology are considered.
- Entrance Exam: The university conducts an online entrance exam (MCQs in Chemistry, Biology, and Physics).
- English Proficiency: An interview assesses English language proficiency.
- Application: Apply online through the official university website.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Fill out the online application form available on the Medical University of Warsaw's official website.
2. Step 2: Gather all required documents, ensuring they meet the university's specified criteria for international students.
3. Step 3: Submit the application form along with the necessary documents to the university before the July deadline.
4. Step 4: Await the university's review of your application and documents by the admission authorities.
5. Step 5: If shortlisted, prepare for the online entrance exam, which tests knowledge in Chemistry, Biology, and Physics.
6. Step 6: Participate in an interview to assess your proficiency in the English language, as the MBBS program is taught in English.
