3. Step 3: Prepare all necessary documents, ensuring they are equivalent to the local SSC and HSC standards.
4. Step 4: Apply to Monno Medical College, keeping in mind the application deadline of March 31, 2026, for the MBBS and nursing programs.
5. Step 5: Await the selection process, which is based on marks obtained in previous qualifying exams.
6. Step 6: If selected, you will receive an offer letter from Monno Medical College.
