- Minimum marks: Specific minimum marks in 10+2 may be required; refer to university guidelines.
- Qualifying exams: Must have passed the 10+2 examination from a recognized board.
- Indian citizenship: Generally, applicants must be Indian citizens or hold relevant residency status.

1. Step 1: Qualify for NEET: The student must qualify for the NEET exam and possess a valid scorecard as per NMC guidelines.
2. Step 2: Application Submission: Apply to the chosen Russian medical university through their official website for the 2026–2027 academic session.
3. Step 3: Document Preparation: Prepare essential documents, including academic transcripts, NEET scorecard, and a migration certificate from your...
4. Step 4: University Assessment: The university will review your application and documents to determine your eligibility for admission.
5. Step 5: Admission Confirmation: Upon successful assessment, the university will issue an admission confirmation letter.
6. Step 6: Visa Application: Apply for a student visa (Long-Stay Type D) at the Russian embassy or consulate in India.
