ELIGIBILITY

- **NEET Qualification:** Must qualify in the NEET exam as per NMC guidelines.
- **Age Requirement:** Must be 17 years or older by December 31, 2026.
- **Academic Qualification:** Completion of 10+2 or equivalent with required subjects.
- **Minimum Marks:** Achieve required minimum marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- **Nationality:** Primarily for Indian students seeking MBBS abroad.
- **Valid Passport:** Possess a valid Indian passport for international travel.
