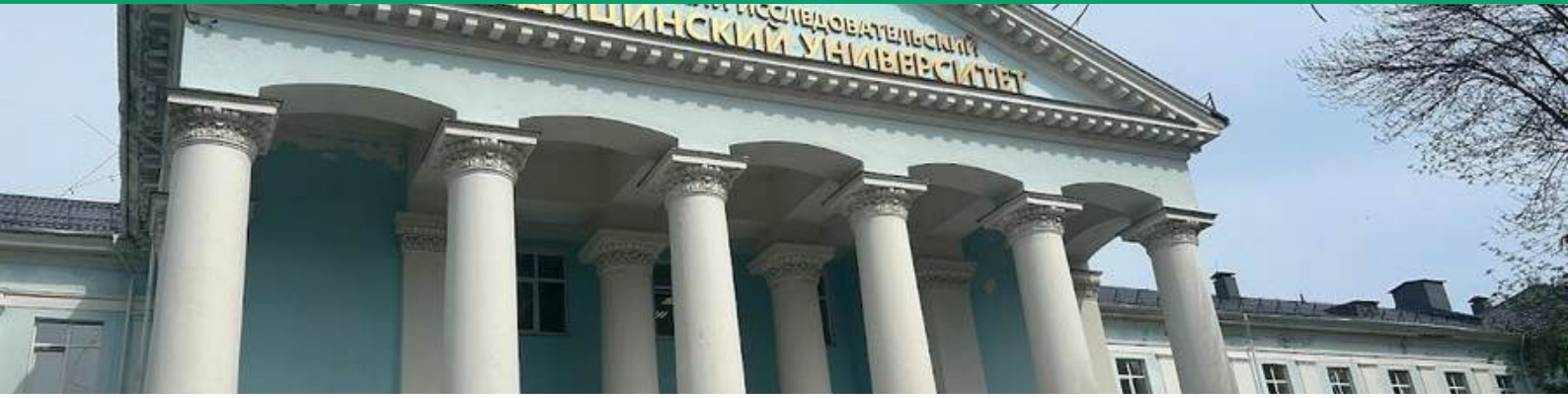

ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify in NEET as per NMC guidelines for the 2026 intake.
- Age: Must be 17 years or older as of December 31, 2026.
- Academics: Completion of 10+2 education with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology as main subjects.
- Minimum marks: Specific percentage requirements in 10+2 may apply; check university guidelines.
- Qualifying exams: May require IELTS or TOEFL; check university requirements.
- Indian citizen: Applicant must be an Indian citizen or hold relevant citizenship status.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Qualify for NEET: Indian students seeking admission in 2026–2027 must qualify for the National Eligibility Entrance Exam (NEET).
2. Step 2: Application Submission: Apply to Nizhny Novgorod State Medical University (now Privolzhsky Research Medical University) before the...
3. Step 3: Document Submission: Submit required documents, ensuring they are authorized and verified by the Ministry of External Affairs, India.
4. Step 4: Document Notarization and Translation: Notarize and translate all documents into Russian before submission.
5. Step 5: Age Requirement: Ensure the applicant is at least 17 years old as of December 31st of the admission year.
6. Step 6: University Registration: Register at the university within 3 days of arriving in Russia.

- 6-month bank statement of parent/guardian
- No-Objection Certificate
