In 2015, the academy achieved university status and received IVth level recognition, cementing its position as a leading medical institution in the Siberian region. ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify NEET in 2024, 2025, or 2026 as per NMC guidelines.
- Minimum age: 17 years old by December 31st of the admission year.
- 12th/Inter marks: 50% in PCB (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) for general category.

- 12th/Inter marks: 40% in PCB (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) for reserved category.
- Qualifying exam: Must have passed 12th/Inter or equivalent examination.
- Passport: Required for application and visa processing.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: July.

1. Step 1: Submit scans of your 12th standard mark sheet, passport, and NEET qualification (2026/2025/2024) to the university.
2. Step 2: Ensure you have secured 50% marks in 12th/Inter/Equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (40% for reserved categories).
3. Step 3: Verify that you have qualified for the NEET exam in 2026, 2025, or 2024 as per NMC guidelines.
4. Step 4: Confirm you will be 17 years old or above by December 31st of the admission year (2026).
5. Step 5: Await the official invitation letter for study from the Department of Federal Migration Service of the Russian Federation.
6. Step 6: Upon receiving the admission letter, visit the Russian Embassy/Consulate in your country to apply for a student visa.
