ELIGIBILITY

- **NEET Qualification:** Must have a valid NEET score as per NMC guidelines.
- **Academic Requirement:** Minimum 75% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in Class XII.
- **Qualifying Exam:** Must have passed HS/'A' level or an equivalent examination.
- **Age Requirement:** Must fulfill the age criteria as per university regulations.
- **Educational Documents:** Submission of required educational certificates and transcripts.
- **Letter of Recommendation:** A letter of recommendation from the previous school is required.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: June.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including a minimum of 75% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in Class XII.
2. Step 2: Qualify for the NEET exam as per the cutoff declared for the respective year. NEET qualification is mandatory for Indian students.
3. Step 3: Obtain the application form from the Suez Canal University Faculty of Medicine or its authorized representatives.
4. Step 4: Fill out the application form accurately with all required details, including personal and academic information.
5. Step 5: Attach scanned copies of necessary documents such as your passport, NEET scorecard, and Class XII mark sheet.
6. Step 6: Obtain a letter of recommendation from your school, highlighting your academic performance and character.
