ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify NEET with a valid score.
- Age: Must be 17 years or older as of December 31, 2026.
- Academics: Completed 12th standard with 50% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- Subjects: Physics, Chemistry, and Biology must be core subjects in 12th.
- English Proficiency: Demonstrate English proficiency for international applicants.
- Application: Submit the Tbilisi State Medical University tuition fee.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including being 17 years old by December 31st of the admission year (2026).
2. Step 2: Have passed the class 12 examination with a minimum of 50% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
3. Step 3: Qualify for NEET, as a NEET certificate is required for Indian students.
4. Step 4: Prepare the necessary documents for application, ensuring they are verified for submission.
5. Step 5: Demonstrate English proficiency, as the MBBS course is taught in English.
6. Step 6: Apply through the official application portal of Tbilisi State Medical University.

- 6-month bank statement of parent/guardian
