ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify NEET with a score at or above the 50th percentile.
- Age: Must be 17 years or older as of December 31, 2026.
- Academics: Completion of 10+2 or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- Minimum grades: Achieve required grades in science subjects (specifics not provided).
- MSAT-Malaysia: Required to take the Medical Students Admission Test-Malaysia (MSAT) in 2026.
- MSAT Dates: MSAT-Malaysia 2026 test dates are 24th, 25th, 26th, or 27th February 2026.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: October.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the basic eligibility criteria, including academic qualifications and NEET score requirements for studying MBBS abroad.
2. Step 2: Prepare for and sit for the Medical Students Admission Test-Malaysia (MSAT-Malaysia 2026), a pre-requisite entrance test.
3. Step 3: Register for MSAT-Malaysia 2026 and choose your preferred test date from available options in February 2026.
4. Step 4: Apply to Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM) MBBS Programme through the UPU Online website or via UM Open Channel.
5. Step 5: Await the MSAT-Malaysia 2026 results, which will be sent to the email address you registered with.
6. Step 6: If shortlisted based on MSAT-Malaysia 2026 results, you will be invited to attend a selection interview.
