ELIGIBILITY

- NEET Requirement: Qualify for NEET as per NMC guidelines.
- Age Requirement: Minimum 17 years of age by December 31, 2026.
- Academic Requirement: 65% marks in Grade 12 (Higher Secondary).
- GPA Requirement: Minimum GPA of 3.0 out of 4.0 may be required.
- English Proficiency: IELTS score of 5.5 or TOEFL score of 60.
- Entrance Test: MSAT-Malaysia is a pre-requisite entrance test.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: October.

1. Step 1: Complete the online application form available on the University of Malaya's official website for the 2026 intake.
2. Step 2: Ensure you meet the minimum academic requirements, including at least 65% marks in Grade 12 for undergraduate programs.
3. Step 3: Prepare required documents such as academic transcripts, passport copy, personal statement, and medical certificate.
4. Step 4: For B.A/B.S Medicine and Surgery, ensure you have the required GPA of 3.0 and English proficiency scores (IELTS 5.5 or TOEFL 60).
5. Step 5: Register and sit for the Medical Students Admission Test-Malaysia (MSAT-Malaysia 2026), a pre-requisite for the MBBS program.
6. Step 6: Pay the non-refundable application fee as specified by the university; note that fees may vary by program.
