ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify NEET with a score at or above the 50th percentile.
- Age: Must be 17 years or older as of December 31, 2026.
- Academic Qualification: Completion of 10+2 or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- Qualifying Marks: Specific marks requirements in 10+2 may apply; check official guidelines.
- NMAT Exam: Required after the first 16 months of the pre-medical course.
- Passport: Valid passport with a minimum validity of one year is required.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Pass the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) in India as it is mandatory for Indian students seeking MBBS admission abroad.
2. Step 2: Fill out the application form available on the University of Perpetual Help System DALTA website.
3. Step 3: Attach all required documents as specified by the university, ensuring they are complete and accurate.
4. Step 4: Submit the filled application form along with the necessary documents through the online portal.
5. Step 5: Await review of your application by the University of Perpetual Help System DALTA admission committee.
6. Step 6: If shortlisted, the university will contact you for enrollment and further processing.
